



**Program Spotlight on Bothy Cottage**

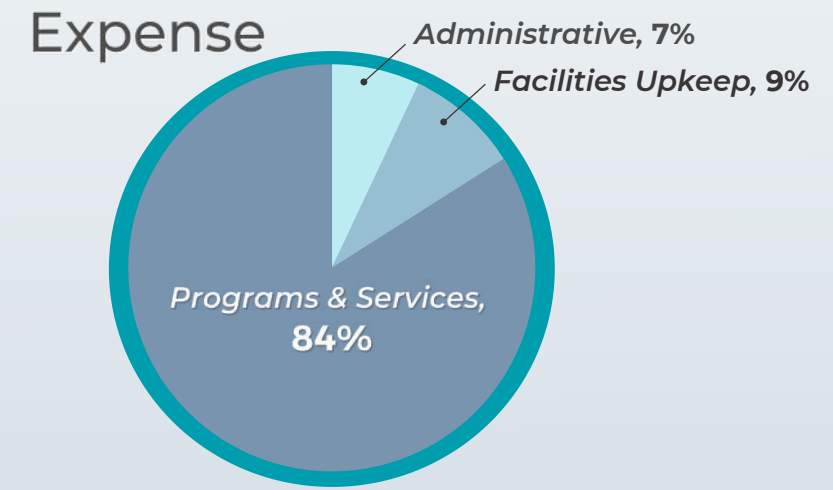
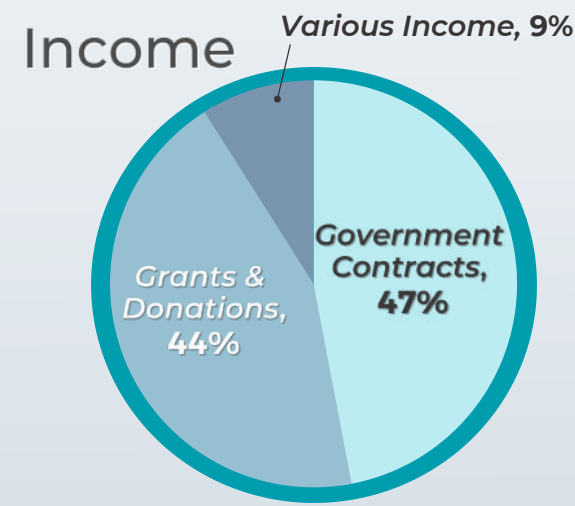
**The cottage was built with support from generous local partners!**

Bothy Cottage, located at Sponsors Downtown Campus, opened its doors in 2014 with a special focus on providing safe, supportive housing and programs for mothers reuniting with their children. Folks living in Bothy participate in parenting classes and programs geared towards strengthening families and increasing resilience. Families can live in the cottage for up to one year. **In 2019 & 2020 a total of 14 mothers and 25 children lived at Bothy Cottage.**

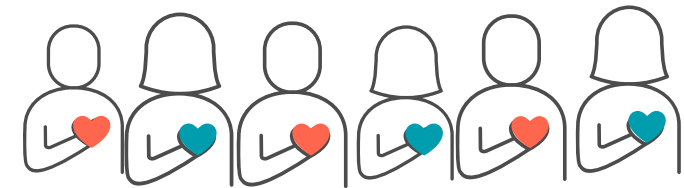
