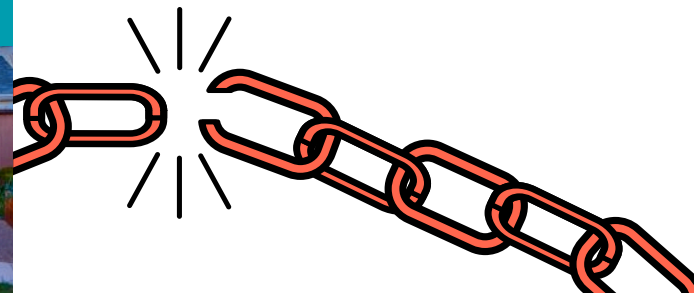

- Formerly incarcerated people are **10 times** more likely to experience homelessness. Your partnership provides transitional and semi-permanent housing that reduces homelessness in our community
- In 2018, **27%** of formerly incarcerated people were unemployed. Legacy gifts provide programs that help individuals as they gain professional skills
